For more than four decades, PAMET represented the laboratory professionals and remains to be the true symbol of core values that it represents. It's many years of commitment to its members and its remarkable contributions to the upliftment of the

profession are shining testaments why the organization is considered to be one of the most respected and recognizable professional groups.

On February 7, 2018, PRC issued Resolution No. 2018-1089, Series of 2018 otherwise known as "Revised Rules on the Accreditation of Professional Organizations


ASCP Partners with PAMET

and Integrated Professional Organizations. According to Section 6 of the resolution, one of the qualifications to be an APO is that, the association is "established for the promotion of the benefit and welfare of the professionals of one discipline, the advancement of their profession, and the attainment of other professional ends."

As stipulated in Section 14 of Rule 5, PAMET as APO shall enjoy the following rights and privileges:

- To represent the profession for which such organization has been established and accredited:
- To submit nominees for vacant positions in the Board;
- To bid for the yearly award for the outstanding professional organization;

- d. To nominate for the annual outstanding professional of its profession;
- To designate a representative to sit as the 1st member of the CPD Council;
- f. To be part of the oath taking ceremony of the new professionals;
- g. To represent the profession in the Monitoring Committee for the ASEAN MRAs, if applicable; and
- h. To exercise analogous rights and privileges under the law.

Section 15, on the other hand, states the duties and responsibilities of APO as follows:

- a. To define the professional responsibilities of its members;
- b. To ensure that its members adhere to the Code of Ethics,

- responsibilities and highest professional and technical standards;
- To improve the standards of the profession through effective collaboration with the Board and the PRC;
- d. To look into the conditions affecting the practice of the profession and to propose policies or measures to the Board or the PRC for improvement;
- e. To ensure the welfare, and best interest as well as harmonious relationship among its members; and
- f. To report violations of the Professional Regulatory Law to the PRC, through the Office of the Legal Service, for possible prosecution or filing of complaint.


Queen City of the Philippines Hosts the 9th PAMET Visayas Regional Conference
